"**Google Bubble No-1**" is a tech-satire comedy series based on absurd but real events from the digital world.

The story follows a website owner whose analytics suddenly collapse into chaos — one system shows normal traffic, another shows nothing, and Google Analytics insists on reporting a single lonely visit.

As he tries to understand what's happening, the series cuts between his real world and a fictionalized Google Analytics headquarters in Ireland, where analysts panic, managers overreact, and the Legal Department rules with iron logic and zero transparency.

The show blends **real digital frustrations** with **absurd corporate humor**, creating a parallel universe where every analytics tool lives in its own reality and everyone pretends they're right. It's *The Office* meets *Silicon Valley*, told through the lens of someone who just wanted his website to load faster — and accidentally triggered a corporate meltdown.

Tone: fast, witty, meta, grounded in true events

Format: 30-minute single-camera comedy

Core theme: The digital world isn't evil or smart — it's just comically inconsistent.
